The Graduate School Foreign Language Test for the Fall 2026 semester will be conducted as follows. Students who wish to take the test must complete their application within the designated period.

- Eligibility: Students who have completed registration at the Graduate School(applications are accepted regardless of credits earned)
- Application Method: Log in to 통합정보시스템 (Portal) → 학사행정(Academic Administration) → 졸업(Graduation) → 외국어시험관리(Foreign Language Test Management) → 외국어시험신청(Foreign Language Test Application)

※ Qualifications submitted through other menus (e.g., Foreign Language Qualification Management) will not be recognized.
Applications must be submitted through the Foreign Language Test Application menu within the application period.
